Green Was te Collection Starts Monday, **5 November 2018**.



What can be collected?

The Shire and its contractors will collect garden green waste. Tree prunings should be no longer than 1.5m to aid handling and removal.

Where should I put my green waste for collection?

Please place your green waste on the verge, away from fences, power poles, water meters and other obstacles. This will ensure safe access for the trucks, loaders and bobcats used for collection. To avoid disappointment, we recommend you have waste on the verge ready for collection by Sunday, 4 November. Please note we cannot enter private property to collect waste.

Do I need to separate my green waste? We are asking residents to group their waste into piles. Things that can be mulched (ie branches and tree cuttings) should be separated from palm fronds which cannot be mulched. Loose litter such as leaves should be bagged for collection so they do not blow around. Separating waste will help us deal with the green waste as efficiently as possible, maximising mulching and minimising the amount that needs to go to landfill.



What happens to the mulch?

Mulch will be available to residents FREE OF CHARGE following the collection. It will be located behind the Shire nursery and can be accessed from Willersdorf Road.
