SUMMARY

This report recommends the Council of the Shire of Exmouth adopt the 2012/13 Budget.

BACKGROUND

Council is required to prepare and adopt in the manner and form prescribed its annual budget by no later than the 31 August each year in accordance with Section 6.2 of the Local Government Act 1995.

COMMENT

The Draft Budget for 2012/13 has been prepared in accordance with the Local Government Act and is attached for consideration and final adoption (Refer *Attachment 3*).

The draft Budget includes a number of key projects, including Capital Program featuring \$15 million of planned works, with the main projects being:

0	Oval Lighting Towers	\$500,000
0	Underground Power CBD Area	\$650,000
0	Construction of Sea Wall	\$690,000
0	Housing Initiative	\$950,000+
0	Thew St Upgrade	\$1.1m
0	Ningaloo Centre	\$2m
0	Federation Park Redevelopment	\$2m
0	Flood Mitigation Project	\$3.7m

The draft Budget incorporates a general rate increase of 3% which has been based on an estimate of the general increase in the net cost of services.

Rubbish Removal Charges:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth set the following rubbish removal charges:

- a. Residential \$337.50 for the weekly removal of each 240 litre mobile garbage bin; one collection per week.
- b. Commercial \$263.50 for the weekly removal of each 240 litre mobile garbage bin; one collection per week

Due Date for Payment of Rates and Charges:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with the Local Government Financial Management Regulations 1996 – Clause 64(1) set the due date for the single payment of a rate or service charge for the 2012/13 financial year to be 10 September 2012.

Due Date for Payment of Rate Instalments

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with the Local Government Financial Management Regulations 1996 – Clause 64(2) set the due date for the payment of rate instalments for the 2012/13 financial year as follows:-

First Instalment	10 September 2012
Second Instalment	12 November 2012
Third Instalment	14 January 2013
Fourth Instalment	14 March 2013

Options for Payment of Rates and Charges:

Option 1: Prompt Payment Due no later than 4:00pm on 10 September 2012

Option 3: Four equal instalments

- i) First instalment due no later than 4:00pm on 10 September 2012
- ii) Second instalment due no later than 4:00pm on 12 November 2012
- iii) Third instalment due no later than 4:00pm on 14 January 2013
- iv) Fourth instalment due no later than 4:00pm on 14 March 2013.

Option 2: Two equal instalments

- i) First instalment due no later than 4:00pm on 10 September 2012;
- *ii)* Second instalment due no later than 4:00pm on 12 November 2012.

Administration Charge on Instalments:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with Section 6.45(3) of the Local Government Act 1995 and the Local Government Financial Management Regulations 1996 – Clause 67 set an administration charge of \$11.50 per rate instalment notice for the 2012/13 financial year where the instalment plan is selected.

Interest on Rate Instalments

That Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with Section 6.45(3) of the Local Government Act 1995 and the Local Government Financial Management Regulations 1996 – Clause 68 set as an additional charge by way of interest where the instalment plan is selected an interest rate of 5.5% for the 2012/13 financial year.

Late Payment Interest Charge:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with Section 6.51(1) of the Local Government Act 1995 and the Local Government Financial Management Regulations 1996 – Clause 70 set an interest rate of 11% for the 2012/13 financial year as penalty interest for the late payment of rates and charges.

Interest on Money Owing to Council – General Debtors:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with Section 6.13(1) of the Local Government Act 1995 set an interest rate of 11% for the 2012/13 financial year and in accordance with Section 6.13(6) of the Local Government Act 1995, the period of time after which an account incurs interest is 60 days.

Reserve Fund:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with Section 6.11 of the Local Government Act 1995 create Reserve Funds and allocate funds to and from the Reserve Funds for the financial year ending 30 June 2013 as specified in the 2012/13 Budget document.

Trust Fund Budget:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth adopt the Trust Fund Budget for the financial year ending 30 June 2013 as included in the 2012/13 Budget.

Imposition of Fees and Charges:

That the Council of the Shire of Exmouth in accordance with Sections 6.16 and 6.17 of the Local Government Act 1995, Health Act 1911, Cemeteries Act 1986, Dog Act 1976 and other relevant legislation, adopt the Schedule of Fees and Charges for the financial year ending 30 June 2013 as included in the 2012/13 Budget.

Material Variance:

The 2012/13 Financial Statements presented to Council during the Financial Year for review and comparison to Budget will indicate Variance Value plus (+) or minus (-) of 10% or \$10,000, whichever is the greater.

Call Tenders:

Authorise the CEO to call Tenders for Goods and Services where there is provision in the 2012/13 Budget, with Council to determine the outcome of all Tenders.
