## Exmouth's Paltridge Memorial Swimming Pool

With the commencement this month of the pool season for 2020-2021, from Monday 28 September, the Exmouth pool will be open seven days a week until closure of the pool on Friday 7 May. Opening hours for the pool are:

Saturday, Sunday & Public Holidays: 12.00 noon to 6.00pm Note: Not open for the following public holidays: Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day & Good Friday Early morning swimming sessions will commence from Monday 26 October 2020 and then continue to Friday 26 March 2021 on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings between 6.00 am and 7.30 am.

## Keep Australia Beautiful (WA) Community Litter Grant

The Shire of Exmouth was successful recently in obtaining a Keep Australia Beautiful (WA) Community Litter Grant for the \$5,000 sought. This grant will be used to undertake a community and visitor education campaign with informational signage placed along a 20 km length of the main road into and out of Exmouth – Murat Road - reminding people to not discard rubbish from cars and to secure their loads of equipment and/or waste in trailers and boats as they travel along this road. Additionally, the Shire will make available paper car litter bags at the town's petrol stations to encourage people to keep their waste safe until they can correctly dispose of it. A community clean-up day will be held in June 2021.

### Exmouth Eagles Win Home Grand Final

For the first time in 27 years, Exmouth Eagles Football Club hosted the Gascoyne Football Association Grand Final. The Exmouth vs Carnarvon Colts game was a great curtain-raiser with the final scores, Exmouth 70 Carnarvon 41. Around 1,500 people turned out to support the league teams as they played for the Gascoyne Football Association's Jack Henneberry Memorial Premiership Cup. Exmouth Eagles Football Club were the winners on the day with the Carnarvon Ramblers Tigers fighting hard until the final siren. Final scores were Exmouth Eagles 109, Ramblers Tigers 51. Best on the ground was Exmouth Eagles Matthew Jones. Gascoyne Football Association Best and Fairest for 2020 was Exmouth Eagles Chase Faxon. Congratulations to the Exmouth Eagles Football Club committee for the fantastic work they did for the hosting of this Grand Final.
