DAIP REVIEW

The Shire of Exmouth is reviewing its 2015-2020 Disability Access and Inclusion Plan and is working with the community to set the goals for improving universal access and inclusion in the next five year plan. An initial consultation session was held on 19 August, getting the wheels rolling on what has gone well in the previous plan, what still needs action, and what the current community sees as vital to good social inclusion for all abilities. Seven key objectives are set by legislation to be included in the plan and are crucial to ensure a broad-reaching plan. The whole community (including older adults, people with prams, those who speak English as a second language) will benefit from improved access and we encourage anyone with diverse access needs to take part in a survey. Further feedback can be provided in coming weeks via a survey placed on the Shire's website (also available on an iPad in the library and in hardcopy format at the Shire's Customer Service reception). EXMOUTH BIKE PARK

At the July 2021 Shire of Exmouth Ordinary Council Meeting, Council awarded the contract for Tender RFT 01-2021 Exmouth Bike Park to Common Ground Trails Pty Ltd. The Exmouth Bike Park was a recommendation of the Ningaloo Trails Masterplan that was adopted in 2018.

The Exmouth Bike Park will be built in stages with construction for stages one and two to begin late September. The site location for the Bike Park is the area bounded by Willersdorf Road to the east, Exmouth Community Garden to the north, Exmouth Tennis Club to the south and the Emergency Overflow to the west. Funding of \$300,000 for this recreational facility has been confirmed by the bike park's partners: Woodside and Mitsui E&P.

Community consultation will be undertaken to assist with the outcome of this public recreation facility. Students from the Exmouth District High School will be involved in assisting to create a safer more engaging space for the youth and families of Exmouth.
