DOGS AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2014

Under the powers conferred by the *Dog Act 1976*, *Local Government Act 1995*, and all other powers enabling it, the Council of the Shire of Exmouth resolved on 18 December 2014 to make the following local law.

1. Citation

This local law is cited as the *Shire of Exmouth Dogs Amendment Local Law 2014*.

2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. Dogs Local Law amended

The *Shire of Exmouth Dogs Local Law* published in the *Government Gazette* on 10 July 2000 and as amended and published in the *Government Gazette* on 1 June 2004 is referred to as the principal local law. The principal local law is amended as follows.

4. Clause 2.4 deleted

Clause 2.4 is deleted.

5. ‘Authorized’ replaced

‘authorized’ is replaced with ‘authorised’ wherever it appears.

6. Clause 1.3 amended

Clause 1.3 is amended as follows—

- (a) The definition of ‘Regulations’ is deleted and replaced with—
“Regulations” means the *Dog Regulations 2013*;
- (b) The definition of ‘town planning scheme’ is deleted; and
- (c) The following is added to clause 1.3 at the appropriate place—
“local planning scheme” means a local planning scheme made by the local government under the *Planning and Development Act 2005* which applies throughout the whole or a part of the district.

7. Clauses 5.1 deleted

Clause 5.1 is deleted.

8. Clause 5.2 deleted

Clause 5.2 is deleted.

9. Clause 4.4 amended

In clause 4.4 ‘town’ is replaced with ‘local’.

10. Clause 4.7 amended

In clause 4.7 ‘town’ is replaced with ‘local’.

11. Schedule 3 amended

Schedule 3 is deleted and replaced with the following—

Schedule 3**Offences in respect of which modified penalty applies**

(Clause 7.2)

1	3.1	Failing to provide means for effectively confining a dog	\$100	\$100
2	4.9	Failing to comply with the conditions of a licence	\$100	\$200
