Can you remember the last time an experience or a place left you feeling awestruck?

The stunning westernmost tip of Australia sparks feelings of wonder in visitors of all ages. The weather is welcoming all year long, and the breathtaking landscape of the gorges and canyons of Cape Range National Park is rivalled only by the experience of swimming alongside spectacular whale sharks, humpbacks, turtles, and manta rays on Ningaloo Reef.

THE WONDER OF THE LAND

Journeying into the rugged limestone ranges of Cape Range National Park is akin to travelling back in time. Discover millennia of indigenous history alongside shot holes from the oil exploration work of the 1950s.

While on a four-wheel drive tour through the 50,000 hectares of ancient landscape, enjoy sweeping views of Shothole Canyon's gorges, admire some of the 630 species of wildflowers, spot an abundance of wildlife, and get a 360° view that explains why we say this is where the reef meets the range.

THE WONDER OF THE SEA

Western Australia's eco-tourism capital is home to the country's largest fringing reef system, which stretches 300 kilometres along the World Heritage-listed Ningaloo Coast. Step from white, sandy beaches into turquoise waters, where you can encounter more than 700 species of fish and 250 varieties of coral— no boat necessary!

THE WONDER OF AN ENCOUNTER

Reacquaint yourself with the magic of childhood, where new experiences are a source of joy, and adventure can be found around every corner.

Only 1 in 3 million people will have the opportunity to swim with a whale shark, but with a 97% interaction rate, Exmouth is one of the best places in the world to participate in this rare encounter.

Continue your underwater adventure by swimming alongside humpback whales and manta rays, or visit the Big Friendly Grouper at The Exmouth Navy Pier, one of the world's top 10 shore-based SCUBA diving sites.

THE WONDER OF THE SKIES

As the sun shines brightly overhead, take to the skies in a two-seater microlight aircraft. Feel the wind in your face as you fly over the North West Cape, getting a bird's eye view of the reef and the megafauna that call it home.











Bid the sun farewell at Vlamingh Head Lighthouse, one of the only places in the world where you can watch the sun rise and set over the ocean. Pick up a bespoke hamper from the Ningaloo Visitor Centre featuring local products from Exmouth shops for a picnic overlooking Lighthouse Bay as you watch the sun sink into the water, setting the sky and sea ablaze with colour.

The vibrant hues of sunset fade into twilight, and the endless sky above reveals trillions of stars sparkling without the obstruction of city lights. More than 80% of the planet's population lives under a light-polluted sky, but the remote landscape of Exmouth grants an unrestricted view of the Emu in the Sky and the Southern Cross.

THE WONDER OF TIMELESS WISDOM

Traditionally owned by the Baiyungu, Thalanyji and Yinigurdira People, the land historically served as a significant place for many tribes to gather and share stories. Exmouth still draws visitors from many cultures, and its Dreamtime encourages locals and travellers to honour and protect the land and sea.

Join Traditional Owner Hazel Walgar and her family for a sunrise or sunset tour. During the excursion, you can enjoy Dreamtime stories and yarn about Nyinggulu's rich cultural heritage from a Baiyungu woman whose connection to the land spans tens of thousands of years.

THE WONDER OF COMFORT

From the famous burger night at Bullara Station to fresh seafood enjoyed ocean-side, just steps away from your two-bedroom beachfront bungalow at Mantarays Ningaloo Beach Resort, your stay in Exmouth will delight your tastebuds and rejuvenate your senses.
