- ➤ All waste oil, steel drums not cleaned and/or lids not removed, tyres, special burials such as asbestos, batteries, refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners where gas has not been reclaimed for domestic properties will remain in accordance with the 2019/20 Schedule of Fees and Charges.
