Please note, a deputation: (a) is not to exceed 5 persons, only 2 of whom may address the Council, although others may respond to specific questions from members;

(b) is not to address the Council for a period exceeding 10 minutes without the agreement of the Council.

Additional members of the deputation may be allowed to speak with the leave of the presiding member (Chairperson).

At the OCM held on 24 October, Councillors adopted an 'Attendance at Events" policy which is a requirement under section 5.90A of the Local Government Act 1995. The purpose of the policy is to provide transparency about the attendance at events involving elected Councillors and the Chief Executive Officer by establishing guidelines for the appropriate disclosure and management of acceptance of invitations to events or functions. Is your club happy with its club rules (constitution)? Now is a good time to review if your rules are meeting your club's needs. On 31 March 2020, the State Government announced a COVID-19 coronavirus economic and health relief package. The package includes providing a 12 month discount on licensing and similar fees for the 12 month period between 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021 to assist small and medium-sized businesses. The term "licensing-related" fees includes fees for various types of authorisations including licences, registrations, permits, certifications, and extends to incorporated associations and co-operatives.
