### HON MINISTER MICK MURRAY MLA VISITS EXMOUTH







The Honourable Mick Murray MLA, Minister for Seniors and Ageing; Volunteering; Sport and Recreation, visited Exmouth during December and met with representatives of the Shire of Exmouth and community members to announce that \$750,000 will be contributed through the Western Australian Government's Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund (CSRFF) for the \$4.2 million redevelopment of Exmouth's Paltridge Memorial Swimming Pool.

Afterwards, Minister Mick Murray turned the first "sod" of dirt marking the beginning of the construction of the new sports change room that will accommodate Exmouth's surge in female sports participation rates. Besides funding from the Shire of Exmouth, \$142,500 was provided via CSRFF. The project is being undertaken by local contractor C.J. Lord Building & Renovations (WA) Pty Ltd and is due for completion by June 2021.

In attendance at the two events were the Shire of Exmouth's Deputy Shire President Ben Dixon, Councillor Gary Mounsey and CEO Cameron Woods. Also in attendance were WA Labour Candidate for North West Central Cherie Sibosado, local builder Clayton Lord, and WA Women's Football League player Summer Mollross.
