HIKING PROJECT - CAPE RANGE AREA

From 20 May to 22 may this year, two trained bushwalking guides from the company **Off the Beaten Track WA** will be assisting a group of interested members of the Exmouth community learn how to best prepare to go bushwalking as part of a pilot hiking project. This project is being funded by a grant from Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries with equal funding from the Shire of Exmouth.

The WA Hiking Participation Grants Program of DLGSC is aimed at growing participation in hiking in Western Australia through the development and delivery of new opportunities for participation, skills development and capacity of leaders. Upon completion of the this project, eligible participants will have access to selected hiking equipment at Exmouth Tackle & Camping Supplies by way of discounts of up to 20%.

This pilot hiking project will be aimed at developing members of a new hiking club in the Exmouth region.
